4/20	AM: Pipeline Road. PM: Transfer from Canopy Tower to Canopy Lodge.
4/21	AM: Canopy Lodge feeders, La Mesa and Cariguana. PM: Hannibal's for the owl and along the road.
4/22	Anton Dry Forest and Santa Clara beach house.
