### January 3 - January 14, 2018

1/3	Arrive in San Jose, transfer to Hotel Robledal													
1/4	AM: Birding hotel grounds and woods near Walmart. Drove to Cerro de Muerte. Arrived Paraiso Quetzal Lodge at noon. PM: Feeders, lunch, birded lodge grounds.													
1/5	AM: Lodge grounds before breakfast, then birded at El Toucanet Resort.													
1/6	AM: Birded roads near Paraiso Quetzal and the road to Savegre. 9:30AM Breakfast. Tower Road stop at B&B (with feeders), Bosque de Tolomuco (Tayra). Lunch at restaurant with feeders. Arrive Talari Mountain Lodge at 5:30PM.													
1/7	AM: Talari Mountain Lodge grounds before breakfast. Drove to Alexander Skutch's "Los Casingos" reserve. Drove to Villa Lapas.													
1/8	Early AM for Owls and birding the lodge grounds before breakfast. Birded Carara National Park after breakfast. PM: Tarcolos River cruise.													
1/9	AM: Lodge grounds along the river. Breakfast at 8:30. Birded Guacimo Road (dry forest). Drove to La Fortuna with stop at Bogarin's Trail (feeders) and arrived at Arenal observatory Lodge at 6:00PM.													
1/10	AM: Lodge gardens and trails. PM: Peninsula Road within Arenal National Park. Owling on the way to dinner in La Fortuna.													
1/11	AM: Lodge grounds and Waterfall Trail. Lunch stop at "biggest waterfall in Costa Rica" with feeders and trails. Arrived at La Selva at approx 4:15PM.													
1/12	La Selva trails and entrance road before breakfast. Arboreum, lunch and break, then trail between cottage and soccer field.													
1/13	AM: La Selva, breakfast, more La Selva, Comandancia Road (Macaws), Cope's house and environs, transfer to Hotel Robledal.
