3/5	Arrival in Arusha and transfer to Ngare Sero Mountain Lodge
3/6	Lodge grounds AM & PM. Arusha National Park (NP). Picnic lunch nears lake.
3/7	8AM Ngare departure , birded Lark Plains, lunch at Arusha Cultural Center, drove 2 hrs to Tarangire NP, arrived Safari Lodge at 6:00PM.
3/8	Game drives in Tarangire NP: AM - Lemiani Circuit, PM - Small Serengeti.
3/9	AM Tarangire NP game drive, birding around the lodge, lunch in Matete picnic area, drove to Lake Manyara Serene Mountain Lodge.
3/10	Lake Manyara NP game drive from 8AM to 2PM. Birding around the lodge after 4:30PM.
3/11	AM birding at the lodge, then birded along the road to Tlome Lodge (Kilima Tembo). Lunch at Gibbs Farm and birded there until 5:30PM.
3/12	Ngorongoro Crater birding and wildlife viewing.
3/13	AM birding at Tlome Lodge (3 people birded the Ngorongoro Natue Conservancy Area), departed at 1:30PM for Ndutu Lodge in the Serengeti NP (birding enroute).
3/14	Birded Ndutu area: AM - Big Marsh, PM - Lake Masek.
3/15	Departed Ndutu at 8:00AM, drove through the central Serengeti area to Ang'Ata tented camp with birding and wildlife viewing enroute.
3/16	All day in the Seronera area of the Serengeti NP.
3/17	All day in the Seronera area of the Serengeti NP.
3/18	Drove from Ang'Ata to Arusha (Ngare Sero Mountain Lodge) with lunch and limited birding and wildlife viewing enroute. Main tour ended with 1 of the group heading back to the U.S. The remainder of the group staying for the extension.
3/19	Delayed departure due to airline concerns. Drove to Same Elephant Hotel with minor delay as one van was rear-ended by a semi. Lunch at the hotel. Late afternoon birding bush walk.
3/20	Delayed departure due to airline concerns.
3/21	Drove from Same to Muller Mountain Lodge in the West Usambara Mountains birding enroute and on/near the lodge grounds
3/22	AM birding on a road near the lodge. Decision at breakfast to leave after lunch to avoid next day long drive straight to the airport. Arrived KIA Lodge at 7PM.
3/23	Birding on the lodge grounds. Paid day rate to keep the rooms until 6:30PM shuttle to the airport.
