10/31	Cape: Kommetjie (Little Cove), Capetown suburbs - Tokai Forest/Plantation & Lower Tokai (with Margaret for the Sparrowhawk)
11/1	Cape: Rooiels, Betty's Bay (Stony Point Penguin Colony) & the Boulders Penguin Colony
11/2	Cape:Ceres with birding stops enroute (Silvermine Nature Reserve & DuFoietskloof Pass)
11/3	Cape: Karoopoort; R46 roadside birding in the Karoo (Tankwa)
11/4	Cape: Drive from Ceres to Langebaan with birding stops enroute, Rt 46 Veldrif (wetland). Pre-breakfast search for the Protea Seedeater at Guido Pass - Tollhouse (railroad walk)
11/5	Cape: West Coast National Park. Drove to Capetown. Flight to Johannesburg. Drove to Zaaguisdrift lodge.
11/6	B&B: AM birding around the lodge. Drove to Bramasole with birding stops at Polokwane Reserve and the gas station.
11/7	B&B: Bramasole trails in the AM, drove to Mt Sheba with birding stops in Magoebaskloof, the Tzaneen neighborhood for manakins, Agatha Forest for the Bat Hawk, & the road to Mt Sheba.
11/8	B&B: Mt Sheba birding along the road, lunch at Graskop (pancake place), entered Kruger Orpen Gate, drove to Satara Camp.
11/9	B&B: Drove from Satara Camp to Skukuza Camp birding enroute.
11/10	B&B: Birding the roads around Skukuza Camp.
11/11	B&B: Birding the Skukuza grounds, Lake Panic Hide (elephants) and drive to Wakkerstroom.
11/12	B&B: Birding around Wakkerstroom all day.
11/13	B&B: Wakkerstroom wetlands before breakfast, drive to Mkuze, birding in Mkuze.
11/14	B&B: 3 game drives
11/15	B&B: Pre-breakfast walk around the grounds, drive to St Lucia & PM estuary visit.
11/16	B&B: St Lucia Wetlands Reserve - IGwalla Gwalla trail pre-breakfast & Cape Vidal all day with packed lunch.
11/17	B&B: St Lucia Wetlands Reserve - IGwalla Gwalla trail pre-breakfast, drive to Eshowe birding enroute.
11/18	B&B: Dlinza Forest pre-breakfast. Breakfast at Birds of Paradise. Ongoye for remainder of the day.
11/19	B&B: Dlinza Forest pre-breakfast. Drive to Durban (Umhlanga - De Chamoy Estate) with stop at Stanger Sappi Mill wetland/bird hide. PM walk downhill from De Charmoy Estate to a wetland.

11/21	Drakensberg: Sani Pass into Lesotho with a rapid COVID test at the border. Linda's farm near Himeville for the Guerneys Sunbird.
11/22	Drakensberg: Travel day - Drove from Creighton to Johannesburg with a birding stop at Nottingham Road.
