8/13	Flight to Iguazu Falls. Visited the hummingbird feeders at Jardim da Pica Flores.
8/14	Argentina side of Iquazu Falls National Park.
8/15	Uruguan State Park in Argentina.
8/16	Brazil side of Iguazu Falls National Park.
8/17	Flights to Cuiaba, transfer to Piuval Lodge, sunset drive.
8/18	Pre-breakfast birding on the lodge grounds. Drove down the sand road but very quiet. Presentation by the jaguar researcher before lunch. No afternoon birding due to strong wind and rain storm.
8/19	Pre-breakfast birding on Piuval grounds, transfer to Mato Grosso Lodge via the Transpantaniera Highway, lunch at Mato grosso, birded around the lake, late afternoon boat ride on the river.
8/20	Pre-breakfast birding the river trail, birded lake trail after breakfast, departed for Porto Jofre after lunch.
8/21	AM and PM Cuiaba River cruises including the Corixo Negro and Three Brothers river tributaries in search of jaguars and birds.
8/22	AM and PM Cuiaba River cruises including the Corixo Negro and Three Brothers river tributaries in search of jaguars and birds.
8/23	Departed Porto Jofre after breakfast and birded in-route to Mato Grosso arriving for lunch. Then drove to Aymara Lodge birding en-route.
8/24	Pre-breakfast walk on loop trail to 1st river spot. Walked the loop in reverse direction after breakfast. Mid-afternoon drive on the Transpantaniera Highway.
8/25	Pre-breakfast loop trail birding. Departed after breakfast for Jardin de Amazona Lodge with lunch stop in Cuiaba and birding stop at the lake where macaws nest.
8/26	Morning Rio Claro River boat ride to the oxbow for the Cone-billed Tanager. Afternoon birding on the property nears the fish lakes followed by Rio Claro River boat ride for the Umbrellabird.
8/27	Birded the property's long trail after breakfast. Drove to Cuiaba after lunch. Arrived at the Hotel Taina near the Cuiaba Airport at approximately 6:00PM.
8/28	Airport check-in at 5:30AM. Hotel for breakfast. 8:00AM flight from Cuiaba to Sao Paulo. Drove to hotel Ype with stop at the marsh in itatiana and at the lookout just past the entrance to Itatiana NP..
8/29	Morning birding at the Hotel Ype feeders then birded at the deserted pink hotel. Afternoon rained out.
8/30	All day birding at higher elevation Agulhas Negras (Black-and-gold Cotinga location).
8/31	Morning birding the road down from Ype and then at the pink hotel upper trail (Troha Tres Picos). Stopped at the church enroute to Ubatuba.
9/1	Birding along the Folha Seca Ranch road and at Jonas's feeders. Afternoon at Angelim Rainforest.
9/2	Morning at Angelim Rainforest trails. Afternoon at Jonas's feeders.
9/3	Angelim until 10AM. Drove to Sao Paulo with lunch stop at the Tropical Restaurant (with feeders).
