3/15	Arrival in Delhi, transfer to Ashok Country Resort, welcome dinner.
3/16	Departed hotel at 6:30AM, drove to and birded Sultanpur National Park til lunch, drove to Bharatpur birding enroute, checked into the Hotel Sunbird.
3/17	Birded Keoladeo National Park.
3/18	Birded Keoladeo National Park.
3/19	AM: Birded Keoladeo National Park. PM: Drove the Chambal Safari Lodge birding enroute.
3/20	AM: Boat ride on the Chambal River. PM: Black Buck area.
3/21	Wheat fields at Sai Fai, Etowah, Prinias at Sandy Canyon, State Highway 62 Naglataur after lunch, drove to Agra and checked in at the
3/22	AM: Visited the Taj Mahal, late breakfast and then drove to Rathambore National Park birding enroute, checked into the Rathambore Regency.
3/23	AM: Tiger Safari to Zone 7. Midday: Birding public area of the park. Afternoon: Tiger Safari to Zone8. Evening: Hotel grounds for owls.
3/24	AM: Tiger Safari Zone 10. PM: Birding outing to the Chambal River (boat).
3/25	AM: Birding Surwan Lake (Dam) and various nearby spots. PH: Tiger Safari Zone 10.
3/26	AM: Morning train to Delhi. Leisure afternoon.
3/27	AM: Okhla Bird Sanctuary (substitution for 1st day of Bhutan tour due to Delhi to Paro flight reschedule from 3/27 to 3/28). Leisure afternoon.
3/28	Late morning flight from Delhi to Paro Bhutan. Birded Paro Shaba (Wallcreeper), authentic Bhutanese lunch at Babesa Village, drove to Thimphu, birded the Thimphu Sewage Ponds near the Thimphu River.
3/29	Drove to Punakha birding enroute at Dochu Pass, Lamperi (Royal Botanical National Park information trails), Menchuna for lunch, along the Punatsangchu River, checked into the Pema Karpo Hotel.
3/30	Walked along the Punatsangchu River, late breakfast at the hotel, drove and birded at Khruthang (Hoopoe), Punakha Dzong (old fortress), Tashithang Valley, Jaime Dorji National Park, into Gasa Province (Bay Woodpecker), Zamlingthang for picnic lunch, , fortress at end of day.
3/31	Departed hotel, birded along the river, drove to Gangtey Valley birding enroute (Lawa La Pass included), lunch at Kuenphen, drove to Phobjikha Lodge. Rain after lunch shortened our birding time.
4/1	Rained off and on all day. Birded road to Lawa La Pass, lunch at Kuenphen, Crane Center.
4/2	Departed Phobjikha Lodge at 6:00AM, drove over Lawa La Pass (10,984') and Pele La Pass (11,180') birding enroute to Trongsa, checked in at the Yangkhil Lodge.
4/3	Departed Yangkhil Resort at 6:30AM. Birded along road near the hotel, then birded Zhangang Road (Forktails) enroute to Yangthong La Pass (border between Bumthang and Trongsa Provinces), lunch in Gatsey, Tharpaling Monastery for Monals, to Jakar for check-in at the Wangducholing Resort.
4/4	Left Jakar at 6:45AM, birded along the the Chamkherchu River, drove dirt road to Yongkhola crossing over Thrumshing La Pass (12,300 feet), had lunch in Sengor, continued on dirt road to Trogan Villa in the fog and rain.
4/5	Departed the lodge at 4:30AM for birding at Janayia (area beyond the Yongkhola - Limithang Road) and along the Yongkhola - Road back to the lodge.
4/6	AM birding near the Trogon Villa, departed after breakfast for Pro with birding enroute. We encountered stopped traffic at 10:22AM due to falling rocks on the road. Major landslide at 10:57AM. Road cleared at 3:30PM and we departed at 3:50PM. Arrived at the Jakar Wangducholing Resort at 8:30PM.
