10/5	Chobe National Park drive from 6AM to 9AM. Birded enroute to Elephant Sands Lodge with lunch stop at Pandamatanga (Touch of Africa).
10/6	Drove to Thamalakane Lodge in Maun with lunch stop at the Dusty Donkey (in Maun). Birded around the lodge.
10/7	Drove to Khwai Guest House birding enroute.
10/8	Khwai Concession near Moremi National Park (other side of the River Khwai).
10/9	Xakanaxa (Ta-ka-na-ka) boat ride, lunch, then Moremi National Park (north and south sections), drove to Thamalakane Lodge in Maun.
