Intervales State Park in the Atlantic Forest - July 27 to July 31

7/7	Arrival in Sao Paulo, flight to Iguazu Falls BZ, drive to Puerto Iguazu AR, stop at Jardim da Pica Flores for hummingbirds, check-in at the Orquidas Hotel.
7/8	National Road 101, Iguazu Falls National Park Devil's Throat and back, entrance to Orquidas Hotel grounds.
7/9	Early AM on hotel grounds, Iguazu Falls National Park: Macuco Trail, Lower & Upper Falls trails,
7/10	AM: Antenna Road off National Road 12. PM: Iguazu National Park Brazil side, check-in at the Bourbon Hotel.
7/11	Travel day: Flight from Iguazu Falls BR to Sao Paulo BR then bus to Ititiaia National Park, check-in at Hotel Ype.
7/12	Ititiaia National Park: AM to Marumba waterfall along main road. PM: Opposite direction.
7/13	Ititiaia National Park: Upper portion all day (Aguilhas Negras).
7/14	AM: Ititiaia National Park trails near Simon Hotel (old pick building). PM: Transfer to Ubatuba, check in at the Ubatuba Palace Hotel.
7/15	AM: Angelim Reserve. PM: Jonas's feeders and Folha Seca.
7/16	AM: Folha Seca - trail to the end. PM: Angelim Reserve.
7/17	AM: Angelim Reserve, transfer to Sao Paulo, flight to Cuiaba, transfer to Chapada dos Guimares, check-in at Casa da Quineira Lodge.
7/18	AM: Casa de Quineira Lodge due to bad weather (cold, rain, wind, fog). PM: Chapada Waterfall (Veu de Noiva) and Aqua Fria Road (dirt road).
7/19	AM: Geladira Road. Transfer to Jardim de Amazon Lodge birding enroute including the entrance road to the lodge.
7/20	AM: Boat trip on the Rio Claro River including the oxbow. PM: Jatoba Trail on lodge property.
7/21	AM: Ponds and big lake on lodge property. Transfer to Piuval Lodge.
7/22	AM: Piuval Lodge property - road that goes to the bay. PM: Green River via tractor.
7/23	AM: Piuval Lodge property - end of Bay Road. Birding enroute to Porto Jofre Lodge with lunch stop at the Rio Claro Lodge.
7/24	AM and PM outings on the Cuiaba River (for Jaguar sightings and birds, too).
7/25	AM and PM outings on the Cuiaba River (for Jaguar sightings and birds, too).
7/26	AM: Porto Jofre Lodge grounds, transfer to Mato Grosso Hotel with birding stops along the Transpantareira Highway. PM:
7/27	Travel day: Transfer to Cuiaba, flight to Sao Paulo or flights to U.S. or transfer to intervalles State Park.(Pau Pau Guest House).
7/28	AM: Carmo Road. PM: The marsh near reception, a bit of the antpitta trail and the trail near the Pau Pau Guest House.
7/29	AM: Carmo Road (further down the road). PM: The marsh near reception, a bit of the antpitta trail and the trail near the Pau Pau Guest House.
7/30	All day in the park with a late afternoon search for owls and nightjars.
7/31	Early AM birding near the guest house, breakfast, then transfer to Sao Paulo for flights to the U.S.
