7/26/19	Arrival in Sao Paulo, flight to Iguazu Falls BZ, drive to La Cantera Lodge. Birding at Iguazu Falls
7/27/19	Iguazu National Park waterfalls
7/28/19	Uruguai State Park in Argentina (90 km south on Road 12).
7/29/19	Jardin de Picaflares, Puerto Iguazu, Brazil side of the falls, Hotel Bourbon Garden
7/30/19	Flight to Cuiaba. Lunch at Brazilian BBQ. Drove to Pousa Alegre with birding enroute.
7/31/19	AM: Pre-breakfast sunrise birding at water spot. Birded lodge feeders and grounds. PM: Birded different part of lodge grounds and night drive.
8/1/19	AM: Pre-breakfast sunrise birding along entrance road. Drove to Mato Grosso birding enroute. PM: Birded trail along the Pixaim River.
8/2/19	AM: Boat ride on Pixaim River. Birded lodge grounds. PM: Drove to Puerto Joffe with birding stops at the Old Research Station, the Old Homestead and the restroom stop With Macaws.
8/3/19	AM and PM outings on the Cuiaba River (for Jaguar sightings and birds, too).
8/4/19	AM and PM outings on the Cuiaba River (for Jaguar sightings and birds, too).
8/5/19	AM: Porto Jofre Lodge grounds, transfer to Piuval Lodge with birding stops along the Transpantareira Highway.
8/6/19	AM: Boat trip on the lake. PM: Forest birding.
8/7/19	Travel day: Piuval to Gardens of the Amazon Lodge with birding enroute.
8/8/19	AM: Boat trip on the Rio Claro River including the oxbow and forest birding. PM: Some people on boat trip for Umbrellabird; others to the lake for Macaws.
8/9/19	AM: Birded lodge property ponds and forest trail. Drove to Refugio das Aguas for Crested Eagle. Drove to Cuiaba arriving at 9:30PM.
8/10/19	Flight to Sao Paulo and drove to Hotel Ype in Itatiaia National Park with birding stop at the marsh in town.
8/11/19	AM: Ype feeders and Ititiaia National Park trail near Simon Hotel (old pink building). PM: Ype forest trail to waterfall.
8/12/19	Ititiaia National Park: Upper portion all day (Black Needles Road). Some stayed back at Ype and birded the grounds.
8/13/19	AM: Birded Ype grounds and entrance road PM: Drove to Ubatuba, checked in at the Ubatuba Palace Hotel.
8/14/19	AM: Jonas's feeders. PM: Angelim Reserve (most of the group stayed back at the hotel).
8/15/19	AM: Angelim Reserve. PM: Angelim Reserve.
