# NAMIBIA

September 23 through October 7, 2016

9/23	Arrival from the U.S.- transfer to the Birchwood Hotel.
9/24	AM Flight from Johannesburg to Windhoek, transfer to Daan Viljoen Reserve.
9/25	AM: Daan Viljoen Reserve (4WD track). PM - Gammams Wastewater Treatment Plant.
9/26	Depart Daan Viljoen Reserve, transfer to Waterburg Plateau Camp with stop at Von Beck Dam and lunch at the Okahandja Coffe Shop.
9/27	AM: Waterberg Plateau Camp. PM: Game drive to top of plateau.
9/28	Depart Waterburg Plateau Camp for Etodsa (Namutoni Camp) with lunch in Otjiwarongo (at Wimpy's) and stops at the sewage treatment plant and the Dik Dik waterhole.
9/29	Game and birding drive from Namutoni to Halili for lunch and to Taleni Etosha Village Lodge.
9/30	AM: Walk at Taleni, game and birding drive to Okakuejo (lunch stop) and then to Tushari Lodge with waterhole stops enroute.
10/1	All day game and birding drive west of Okakuejo.
10/2	AM: Tushari Lodge grounds. Depart for White Lady Lodge with lunch stop in Khoraxis.
10/3	White Lady Lodge to Uis (Brandberg Rest Camp) with birding and wildlife stops enroute.
10/4	Uis to Spitzkoppe (Hohenstein Lodge) with birding and wildlife stops enroute and a lunch stop in Usakos.
10/5	AM: Hohenstein Lodge then drive to Walvis Bay (Anjacaja Lodge) with lunch in Swakhopmund and birding stops at the waterfront and the Walvis Bay Saltworks.
10/6	Rooibank (dunes - stuck in sand), Swakopmund for lunch at Wild Rocket, the Salt Works, and the Wastewater Treatment Plant next to Dune 1.
10/7	Dune 7 and then flight from Walvis Bay to Johannesburg.
